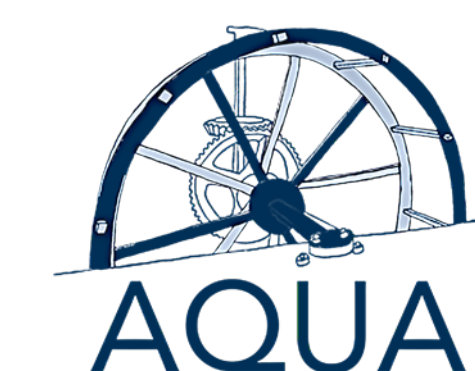

In the 19th century, Portuguese farmers started to plant exotic trees such as Araucaria and Eucalyptus. Just a few works had focused on its healing properties in international bibliography, and the arguments of the Iberian physicians have remained rather uninvestigated. We propose to tackle this question through two paths of experiments on eucalypts in the Iberian Peninsula – experiments related with the acclimatization of eucalypts and the planting of eucalypts for medical reasons.
